Little did we know that, when we finished for Christmas, we would be back in a lockdown situation and that we would not be able to welcome everyone back in 2021.

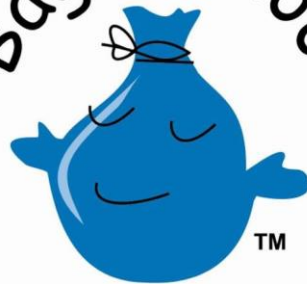
We do now, however, have the hope of a vaccine and are very much looking forward to seeing Mill Hill as it was before the pandemic.

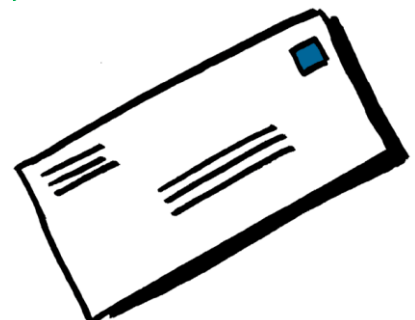


CAN YOU HELP US SECURE EXTRA FUNDING FOR SCHOOL?

If you think your child is entitled to Free School Meals, please do not hesitate to contact the school office, particularly if they are in Key Stage 1. Although all children up to Year 2 are entitled to universal free meals, some are entitled owing to family circumstances. If this is the case, school receives additional funding. If you are eligible, there is a short form to fill in which is available from the office.
