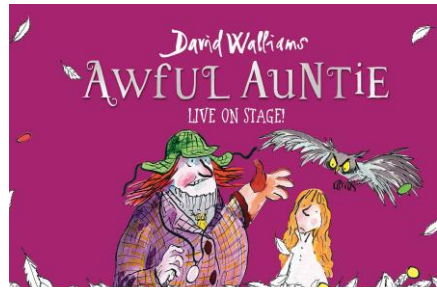

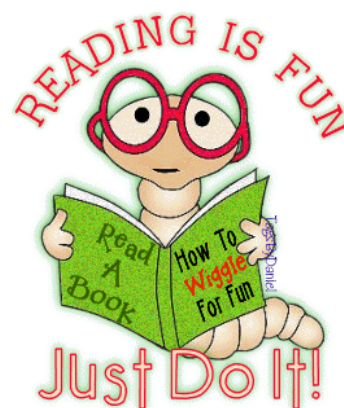
Attending school every day will give your child the best start in life. There are 190 days in the school year which leaves 175 days for family time, shopping, appointments and holidays.
