We have a telephone answering service for this purpose.

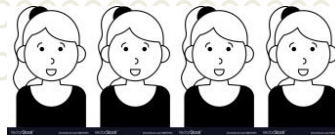
## ART Project

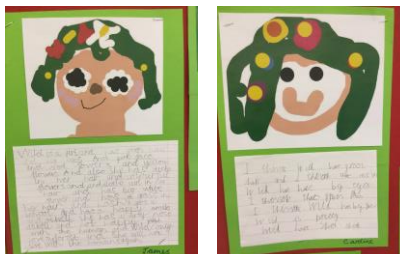


Please ensure that shoulder length hair is tied up.
