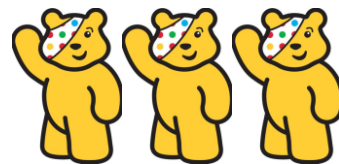

Applications for September 2020 are coming in....if you have a child who needs a place, or know someone who does, please apply online.

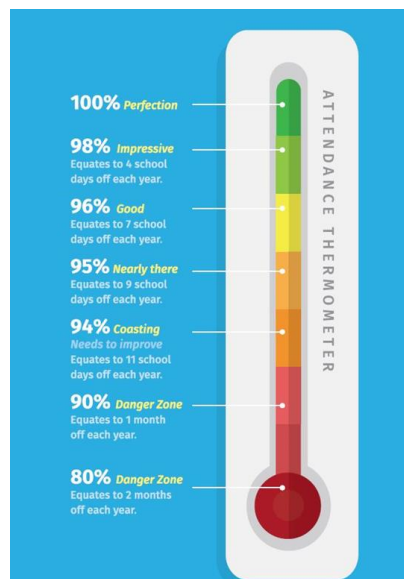


Children with Asthma
