HOLIDAY REQUESTS

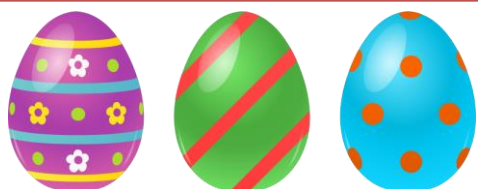
