the register is a legal document. If your child arrives after the register closes they will be marked as 'U' which equates to an absence.



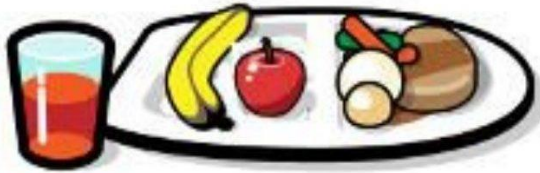
