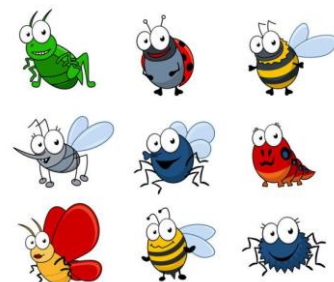
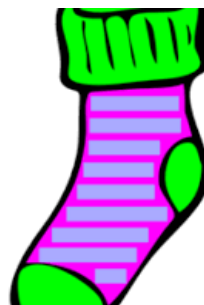
SCHOOL SUPERSTARS OF THE WEEK
