Has anyone signed up for this fantastic nature inspired opportunity? It is completely free and takes place 28th - 30th January.



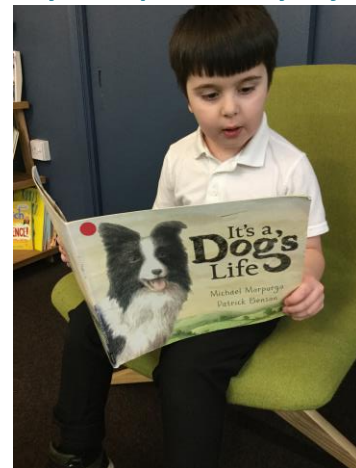
