With access to High Street banks dwindling, it is becoming very difficult to accept cash in school. *We are a cashless school and ask parents to use online payments where possible please.*

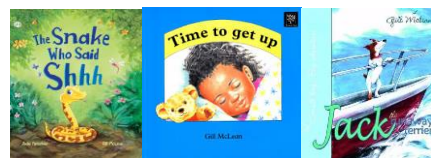
