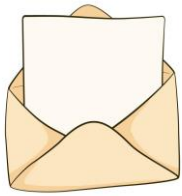

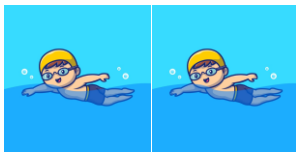


### PE KIT
